The Christian nature of VLC

VLC seeks to be a place where all pupils and staff are welcomed, valued and treated with respect. VLC does not seek to proselytise, but will be open to respond to pupils (outside of learning time) if they seek to develop their own understanding of the meaning and significance of faith.

We, at VLC, believe that we are all created in the image of God and are of unique value. We are inclusive and non-selective. We affirm the importance of each pupil with due regard to their social, ethnic and linguistic background, gender, sexuality, religion, various gifts, needs and abilities and will actively combat discrimination. VLC seeks to create a place where all individuals are respected, supported and nurtured.

The curriculum provided is secular. PSHE and SMSC schemes have no religious bias. Our pupils benefit from our Christian ethos by experiencing our calm, therapeutic atmosphere. A safe place to learn coping strategies for life. If a pupil asks why our centres are based in church buildings, we will always say that we are a Christian School and that all staff support our Christian ethos. Pupils are not required to attend prayer times or to attend Christian services. Our values are shared with our pupils and are based around scripture. The related scriptures will not be shared openly with the students unless they ask.
